Dear Friends and Colleagues:

The Caux Round Table, in partnership with the Convention of Independent Financial Advisors and Berkshire Capital, will be holding its 2016 Global Dialogue from Thursday, July 14th through Saturday, July 16th at the Harvard Club in New York City and you are invited to join us.

The context for this year's Dialogue is a world in confusion. Forces of fragmentation and tribalism seem to be on the rise, undermining confidence in the centrality of common ethics and responsibility for our common destiny. On the other hand, the new U.N. Sustainable Development Goals ("SDGs") provide a dynamic platform for governments, businesses and civil society to band together on behalf of a much better future for all.

Success in implementing the SDGs will depend on several fundamental forces being at work: moral courage, successful and growing economies led by private sector wealth creation and good governance across the board.

The Dialogue proposes to summarize the intellectual guidance coming from its four round table discussion sessions in a proceedings for distribution widely among those concerned for the direction of global affairs.

We are very pleased to have Ambassador Virachai Plasai of Thailand, the current President of the Group of 77 and China, as our guest for lunch on the 15th. The Group of 77 and China play a leading role in shaping the U.N. agenda on sustainable development. Thailand has offered the global community its recommendations on sustainability, derived from its Theravada Buddhist tradition of mindfulness.

We expect as participants in our round tables leaders from the U.N. Economic and Social Council and affiliated organizations, such as the World Business Council for Sustainable Development, the Principles for Responsible Investment initiative of the U.N., the International Integrated Reporting Council and the Alliance of Civilizations.

We are coordinating with the Volcker Alliance, initiated by Paul Volcker, to have their participation with recommendations for reforms of financial institutions the better to support global growth and respond to fundamental human needs for more wealth creation.


All sessions and meals will be held at the Harvard Club.
